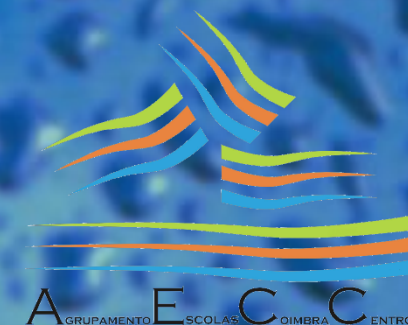

How was the project seen...

- access to museum resources / collection ...
- concentrated on a single platform,
- motivating and sustaining learning
- using ICT
- promoting the "use" of cultural heritage



Erasmus+

How was the project seen...

- activities in Portugal already have
 - knowledge construction by students
 - fostering research
 - use of new technologies
 - promoting collaborative work
- but they also have
 - heavy curriculum
 - lack of physical and material conditions



Erasmus+

What is not new to us...

- methodology
 - the educational activities were already constructive and not scholastic
 - teachers already promote research
 - multidisciplinary was already a goal



This project innovated in which aspects...

- access to museum collections...
- ...both international and national
- ...previously less accessible
- systematic analysis of results - reflective practice



Erasmus+

What we felt...

- the impact of the images, even more of the old images
- the pleasure of exploration / discovery / curiosity
- motivation and the effect it had on students
- the multidisciplinary and the effect that this had as an enrichment of the learning



What precautions did we have...

- control group vs. experimental group...
- exactly the same content
- almost equal classes,
- both at the methodological level and in the strategies used
- the difference was the use of the platform's digital resources



What precautions did we have...

- we could not make the class of the control group more scholastic than normal
- we could not create abnormally adverse conditions
- we tried to isolate the factor - object of study

What results have we had...

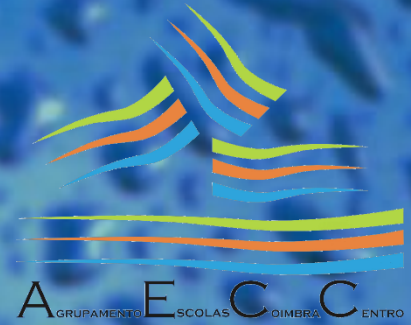
- higher gains in experimental groups
